## 1. Our Commitment to Accessibility

**Green City Security is committed to ensuring that our website, [www.greencitysecurity.com](http://www.greencitysecurity.com), is accessible to everyone, including people with disabilities. We believe that everyone has the right to access information and services online, and we strive to provide an inclusive digital experience for all visitors.**

**We are actively working to increase the accessibility and usability of our website in accordance with the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1, published by the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C).**

## 2. Accessibility Standards

**We aim to conform to WCAG 2.1 Level AA. These guidelines explain how to make web content more accessible to people with disabilities, including those with:**

- Visual impairments (blindness, low vision, color blindness)
- Hearing impairments (deafness or hard of hearing)
- Motor impairments (difficulty using a mouse or keyboard)
- Cognitive impairments (learning disabilities, attention disorders, memory impairments)
- Speech impairments

WCAG 2.1 is organized around four principles, often referred to as POUR:

- Perceivable – Information and user interface components must be presentable in ways users can perceive
- Operable – User interface components and navigation must be operable
- Understandable – Information and operation of the interface must be understandable
- Robust – Content must be robust enough to be interpreted by a wide variety of assistive technologies

## 3. Current Compliance Status

**We have conducted an internal review of our website against WCAG 2.1 Level AA criteria. The table below summarizes our current status across key accessibility areas:**

2.1.1 Keyboard Navigation	<b>Compliant</b>	All functionality is accessible via keyboard alone
2.4.1 Bypass Blocks	<b>Compliant</b>	Skip navigation links are provided
2.4.2 Page Titled	<b>Compliant</b>	All pages have descriptive, unique titles
2.4.4 Link Purpose	<b>Compliant</b>	Link text is descriptive and meaningful in context
2.4.7 Focus Visible	<b>Compliant</b>	Keyboard focus indicator is visible on all interactive elements
3.1.1 Language of Page	<b>Compliant</b>	Page language is programmatically set in HTML
3.3.1 Error Identification	<b>In Progress</b>	Form error messages are being improved for screen reader compatibility
3.3.2 Labels or Instructions	<b>Compliant</b>	All form fields include visible labels and instructions
4.1.2 Name, Role, Value	<b>Compliant</b>	ARIA roles and attributes are applied to interactive components
4.1.3 Status Messages	<b>In Progress</b>	Status messages for dynamic content updates are being reviewed

## 4. Known Limitations

**While we strive for full WCAG 2.1 Level AA compliance, we are aware of the following known limitations and are actively working to address them:**

- Some older PDF documents linked from the website may not be fully accessible. We are reviewing and remediating these files on an ongoing basis.

- Certain third-party embedded content (such as map widgets and live chat tools) may not fully meet our accessibility standards. We are working with our vendors to improve this.
- Error messaging on some contact and quote request forms is being enhanced to provide more descriptive feedback for screen reader users.

## 5. Assistive Technology Compatibility

**Our website is designed to be compatible with common assistive technologies, including:**

### 5.1 Screen Readers

- NVDA (NonVisual Desktop Access) with Firefox on Windows
- JAWS (Job Access With Speech) with Chrome on Windows
- VoiceOver with Safari on macOS and iOS
- TalkBack with Chrome on Android

### 5.2 Other Assistive Technologies

- Voice control software (e.g., Dragon NaturallySpeaking)
- Keyboard-only navigation
- Browser zoom up to 200%
- High contrast display modes

**Our website includes the following accessibility features:**
